

## **Will Not Use Bengali**

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KARACHI. Pakistan, Feb. 25 (Reuters)—The Pakistan Constituent Assembly today rejected a proposal to include the Bengali language with English and Urdu as the official languages of the Assembly.

Bengali is spoken by two-thirds of the Dominion's population of 65,000,000, but only in East Bengal. Urdu predominates in the western segment of Pakistan.
