PAKISTAN STUDENTS RIOT

15 Injured in Demonstration Against Assembly Members

DACCA, East Pakistan. March 16 (Reuters)—About fifteen Moslem students were injured when police used tear gas and made lathi [night stick] charges on students demonstrating against some members of the East Bengal Assembly at the end of its session here today.

A police officer and some constables were also injured.

The District Magistrate told correspondents that the police fired shots in the air when the demonstrators threw stones, but no one was injured by bullets.
